OPERATIONAL PRECAUTIONS



THESE INSTRUCTIONS ARE FOR YOUR PROTECTION. PLEASE READ THEM CAREFULLY.

- Know the controls and how to stop quickly. READ THIS OPERATOR'S MANUAL and instructions furnished with attachments.
- Wear safety glasses or eye shields when assembling or operating riding mower.
- Do not allow children to operate the machine. Do not allow adults to operate it without proper instruction.
- Do not carry passengers. Do not mow when children and others are around. Disengage power to blades(s) or attachment(s) and stop the engine while others are in the vicinity of the mower.
- 5 Battery fluid (electrolyte) is an ACID and is extremely dangerous. Do not smoke while servicing the battery. Do not service the battery near a open flame or spark.
- Handle gasoline with care, it is highly flammable.
 - A. Use approved gasoline container.
 - B. Never remove the fuel cap of, or add gasoline to, a running or hot engine, or an engine that has not been allowed to cool for several minutes after running. Never fill the tank indoors and always clean up spilled fuel immediately.
 - C. Do not smoke while filling fuel tank.
 - D. Do not run the engine indoors. Open doors if engine must be run in garage. Exhaust fumes contain CARBON MONOXIDE, an ODORLESS and DEADLY GAS.
- Check fuel supply before each use allowing space for expansion as the heat of the engine and/ or sun can cause gasoline to expand.
- Do not operate mower when barefooted. Always wear substantial footwear, preferably steel-toed shoes. Do not wear loose fitting clothing that could get caught in moving parts.
- Clear the work area of objects (wire, rocks, etc.) which might be picked up and thrown. Check all controls for proper function.
- 10. Disengage all attachment clutches, shift to neutral, and set parking brake before attempting to start the engine (motor). When starting engine equipped with a pull starter, stand firm and make sure your feet are well away from the blade(s).
- Disengage power to blade(s) or other attachments(s) and stop the engine (motor) before leaving the operator's position. Always dismount from the left side.
- Disengage power to blade(s) or other attachment(s) and stop the engine (motor) before making any repairs or adjustments.
- Disengage power to blade(s) or other attachment(s) when transporting or not in use.
- 14. Take all possible precautions when leaving the vehicle unattended, such as disengaging power to blade(s) or attachment(s), lower the attachment(s), setting the parking brake, stopping the engine (motor), and removing the key.
- Do not stop or start suddenly when going uphill or downhill. Mow up and down the face of steep slopes; never across the face.

- 16. Reduce speed and exercise extreme caution on slopes and in sharp turns to event tipping or loss of control. Be especially cautious wifen changing direction on slopes.
- 17. Stay alert for holes, rocks, and roots in the terrain and other hidden hazards. Keep away from drop-off. Never operate your riding mower on wet or slippery grass or at a speed which could cause a skid. Exercise care when mowing around a fixed object to prevent the blade(s) from striking it. Never deliberately run over any foreign object.
- Always disengage blade control lever before attempting to remove the mower from a hole or other obstruction.
- Use care when pulling loads or using heavy equipment.
 A. Use only approved drawbar hitch points.
 - B. Limit loads to those that you can safely control.
 - C. Do not turn sharply. Use care when backing.
 - D. Use counterweight(s), wheel weights or tire chains when suggested in attachment(s) instructions.
- 20. Watch for traffic when crossing or near roadways.
- When using attachment(s), never direct discharge of material toward bystanders nor allow anyone near the vehicle while in operation.
- Keep the vehicle and attachments in good operating condition, and keep safety devices in place and in working condition.
- Keep all nuts, bolts, and screws tight to be sure the equipment is in safe working condition.
- 24. Never store the equipment with gasoline in the tank inside a building where fumes may reach an open flame or spark. Allow the engine to cool before storing in any enclosure.
- To reduce fire hazard, keep the engine free of grass, leaves or excessive grease.
- 26. The vehicle and attachments should be stopped and inspected for damage after striking a foreign object, and the damage should be repaired before restarting and operating the equipment.
- Do not change the engine governor settings or overspeed engine.
- 28. When using the vehicle with mower, proceed as follows:
 - A. Mow only in daylight or in good artificial light.
 - B. Never make a cutting height adjustment while the engine (motor) is running if the operator must dismount to do so.
 - C. Shut the engine (motor) off when removing the grass catcher or uncloquing chute.
 - D. Check the blade mounting bolts for proper tightness at frequent intervals.
- 29. Under normal usage, the grass catcher bag material is subject to deterioration and wear. Check the bag frequently for deterioration and wear and replace worn bags. Check that replacement bags comply with the original manufacturer's recommendations or specifications.
- Disengage power to mower before backing up. Do not mow in reverse unless absolutely necessary and then only after careful observation of the entire area behind the mower.
